- > Black/greyscale
- > RGB
- > CMYK
- > No special colors (e.g. HKS, Pantone)



№ 4/6 **HOW SHOULD I CREATE MY DOCUMENT?**

- > In final size
- > Create cutting frame (min. 5 mm distance to the drawing content)
- > Create plan header at the bottom right [in accordance with the EN ISO 7200 standard, design of title blocks (drawing headers) on technical drawings, these are located at the bottom right]



> Do not use cutting or register marks



> Do not create areas as pattern/grid areas

>> 5/6 **ZIP-ARCHIVE:**

> Only compressions or archives in the "ZIP" standard with the extension *.zip and *.rar are permitted (but NO *.7z, *.gz, *.arc or other compression methods). Subfolders in the ZIP archive are possible.

Please name files uniquely. If files with the same file name are uploaded, they will be renamed automatically (consecutive numbering appended).

™ 6/6 **MISCELLANEOUS**:

- > Fold marks, text and drawing content between drawing content and cutting frame may be omitted for production reasons.
- > The same color values can be reproduced differently on different print materials. Speci al colors are simulated in CMYK and do not always correspond to the original tone.
- No guarantee is given for the correctness or completeness of text and image content.
 A spell check does not take place.
- > All files in an order must have unique file names. Capitalization is not a clear distinguis hing feature.
